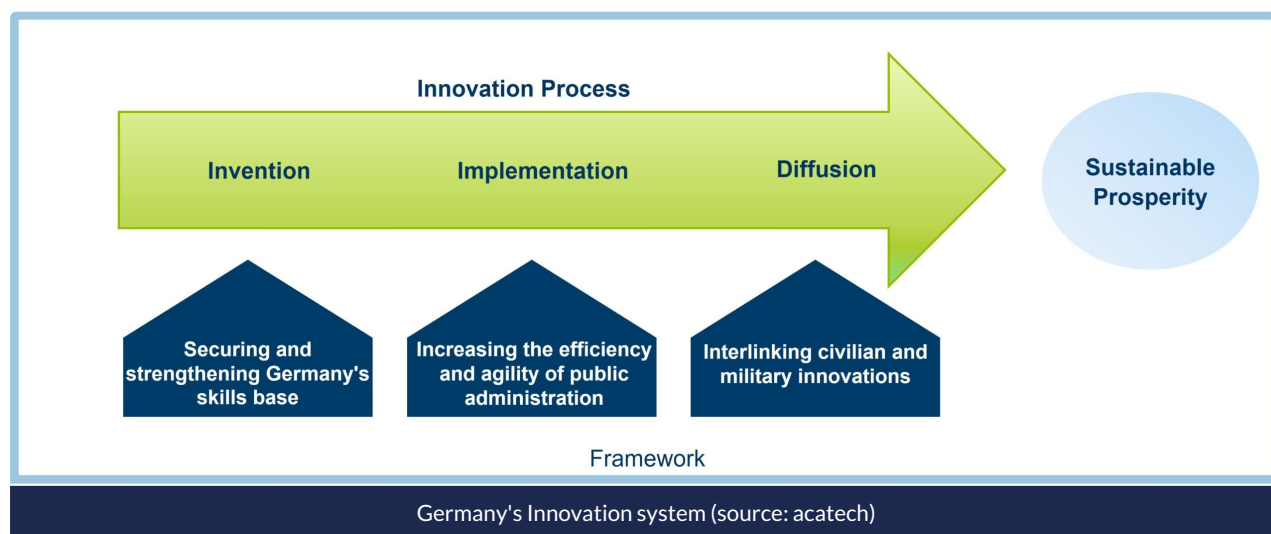
About acatech

Based on the findings, options are identified to define a policy framework that is conducive to innovation and thus enhances prosperity.
